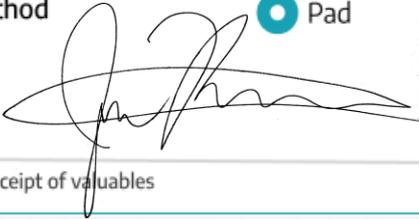

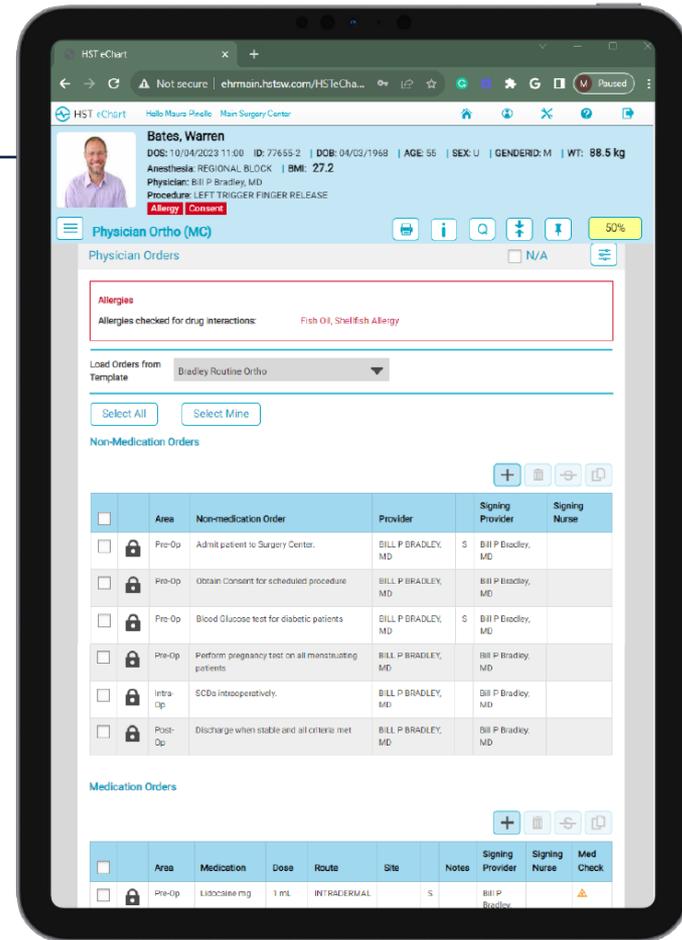

Paper Challenges
